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Requirements to become a Candidate

Students aiming to become a Candidate for membership must meet the following requirements:

- Declare a major in accounting (or have stated an intention to do so)
- Be enrolled in Intermediate I or higher level Accounting course
- Meet **one** of the following GPA requirements (questions about eligibility can be addressed to Dr. Thomas, faculty advisor, at Paula.Thomas@mtsu.edu):
 - A cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher
 - A rank within the top 35% of their university class, or
 - A cumulative grade point average of at least 3.25 on the most recent 15 semester hours
- Complete and submit the following to Dr. Thomas:
 - Candidate Information Sheet (provided in this packet)
 - One-Time Candidate Fee of \$100 (in an envelope with your name on it – check or cash)
 - Copy of MTSU Unofficial Transcript (please include your name on this document)

Requirements for Candidates to become Members

Once accepted as a Candidate for membership, students must complete the following requirements by the end of the semester of candidacy to become a Member of Beta Alpha Psi:

- Faculty Signature Sheet (provided in this packet) – twelve accounting faculty signatures and three BAP officer signatures obtained throughout the semester of candidacy, submitted to Dr. Thomas
- At least **eighteen** combined hours of Professional Activities and Service Activities:
 - Eight hours from Professional Activities, Eight hours from Service Activities, and two hours from either category
 - Professional Activities hours are acquired primarily through BAP meetings
 - Service Activities hours are acquired through plentiful volunteer activities provided by the chapter throughout the semester
- Meet one of the following GPA requirements:
 - A cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher
 - An Accounting GPA of 3.0 or higher
 - A rank within the top 35% of their university class, or
 - A cumulative grade point average of at least 3.25 on the most recent 30 semester hours

Requirements to maintain Active Membership

To maintain status as an active Member, the following requirements must be met by the end of each semester of membership (every semester following your candidate semester):

- At least **sixteen** combined hours of Professional Activities and Service Activities:
 - Eight hours from Professional Activities and eight hours from Service Activities
 - Professional Activities hours are acquired primarily through BAP meetings
 - Service Activities hours are acquired through plentiful volunteer activities provided by the chapter throughout the semesters
