Requirements for Candidacy

Candidates for membership in the Zeta Gamma Chapter must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Declare a major in accounting (or have stated an intention to do so)
- 2. Be enrolled in Intermediate Accounting I or a higher-level accounting class
- 3. One of the following GPA requirements:
 - a. Have attained at least a cumulative grade average of 3.0,
 - b. Have achieved a rank within the top 35% of their university class, or
 - c. Have attained at least a 3.25 cumulative grade average on the most recent 15 semester hours
- 4. Complete/submit the following to Dr. Thomas (faculty advisor) by September 30 (Fall semesters) or February 28 (Spring semesters):
 - a. Candidate Information Sheet
 - b. Candidate dues of \$100
 - c. Copy of MTSU unofficial transcript with your name on it

Requirements for Candidates to become Members

In order to become a Member, a Candidate must complete the following requirements during their semester of Candidacy:

- 1. At least 15 signatures (Faculty Signature Sheet) submitted to Dr. Thomas by the last day of class during the semester of Candidacy
- 2. Earn a minimum of 18 total hours of professional activities and service activities
 - a. A minimum of 8 hours of professional activities (includes chapter meetings with professional speakers)
 - b. A minimum of 8 hours of service activities (sponsored by the chapter)
 - c. The additional 2 hours can be earned in either professional or service activities
- 3. Meet the following GPA requirements:
 - a. Attain a cumulative GPA in upper level accounting classes of at least a 3.0
 - b. One of the following:
 - i. Have attained at least a cumulative grade average of 3.0,
 - ii. Have achieved a rank within the top 35% of their university class, or
 - iii. Have attained at least a 3.25 cumulative grade average on the most recent 30 semester hours

Requirements to Maintain Active Membership

In order to maintain active Membership, Members must fulfill the following requirements each semester:

- 1. Earn a minimum of 18 total hours of professional activities and service activities
 - a. A minimum of 8 hours of professional activities (includes chapter meetings with professional speakers)
 - b. A minimum of 8 hours of service activities (sponsored by the chapter)
 - c. The additional 2 hours can be earned in either professional or service activities
